Product	Garden Furniture Oil
Type	Rustin's Garden Furniture Oil is a blend of oils, resins and driers, with added UV absorbers and biocide to protect the oil from mould.
Intended Use	For all types of exterior wood, and wooden garden furniture.
Special Features	Brings out the natural beauty of wood. Easy to apply and maintain.
Preparation	The bare wood must be clean, smooth, dry and free from wax, dust and contaminants. Remove wax by scrubbing with white spirit or Rustin's Surface Cleaner and a scouring pad, then wipe away whilst still wet with clean rags. Existing paint and varnishes should be removed with Rustin's Strypit Paint and Varnish Stripper . Bare wood may be dyed before coating with Rustin's Wood Dye . Do not apply Knotting.
Application	Using a clean brush apply the first coat liberally and allow to dry. To improve the penetration and durability, the first coat may be diluted 20% with White Spirit. Apply a second and third coat liberally with a brush, wiping off the excess after 10 minutes. Protect furniture from rain, frost and dew until the final coat has dried. Oiled wood requires periodic re-oiling, especially on horizontal surfaces and in very exposed locations. Oak & Softwoods are prone to weather staining caused by moisture activating mould spores present naturally in the wood. If in doubt pre-treat bare wood with a clear (wax-free) preservative. Extra coats of Oil may be required to effectively seal these timbers, especially areas of end grain and joints.
Coats	Apply 3 coats initially; end grain and absorbent areas will require extra coats.
Drying Time	4-8 hours, depending on temperature & Humidity.
Application Temp.	Ideally 15-25°C, do not apply below 5°C or if rain is expected.
Maintenance.	For a superior smooth satin finish, apply a finishing coat as follows: wearing PVC garden gloves, dip a plastic scouring pad into the oil. Apply by rubbing in the direction of the grain wiping away the surplus immediately with a soft cloth or kitchen paper towels.
Coverage	About 12 sq.m per litre, 1 coat, depending on the absorbency of the wood.
Maintenance	Periodic re-oiling is required. When applying to previously oiled wood the surface should be cleaned and any wax removed, using white spirit or Rustin's Surface Cleaner . Wipe away the solution formed with clean paper towels, prior to re-oiling.
Compatibility	May be used over Rustin's Wood Dye .
Shelf-life/Storage	Many years if stored in original, tightly closed container in normal cool, dry conditions.
Hazards	Flammable. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Use in a well ventilated area. Keep out of reach of children. Keep away from sources of ignition – no smoking. Keep container tightly closed. A full Safety Data Sheet is available upon request. Important: Rags used for oiling should be laid out flat to dry; otherwise they may catch fire due to spontaneous combustion.
Clean-Up	Clean brushes with white spirit or Rustin's Brush Cleaner whilst still wet. Hard brushes can be cleaned with Rustin's Brush Restorer .
